NATURE & REASONS of appellant's appeal

1) Appellant ("A") disagrees with the definition of "significant woodlands" in the OP, part of which is that the woodland size is more than one hectare. A believes the size should be bigger for the woodland to be "significant". A suggests a change in the definition to over two hectares, which is based on the "tree cover" in Clarington, and on Provincial policy on this matter.

2) In the alternative, if the definition is not changed, as above requested, then the EP (environmental protection) land use designation should be removed from A's land in Courtice, and from all maps in the OP, including, but not limited to, map A2 and map D1.
